Teaching Aids

Prepare all the teaching aids to review as many as possible of the previous lessons.

- (1) Name the lesson to review such as "The Guardian Angel," using the teaching aid as help.
- (2) Ask questions and let the children answer or answer it yourself as part of the review.
- (3) Make sure that the children have gained a spiritual growth from the lesson, virtue such as loving one another and good habits such as staying quiet in church.
- (4) Repeat the same steps with every lesson that you will be able to review based on the available time.
- (5) Remember that we review the spiritual gain for the children more than testing their knowledge.
