## **A Woman Pours Perfume on Christ's Feet**

### **References**

Luke 7.

### **Notes for Servants**

- ★ Beloved servant, do you give the most precious things in your life to Christ, or you just give things you have no need for.
- ★ Remember that Christ is rich and does not need for anything you can offer, but when you give Him through your loving heart, that will please Him greatly.

### **Objectives**

**General:** Our love for the Lord Christ and His love for us.

#### **Specific:**

The children will be able to...

- A. Learn that God is rich and does not need anything from us, but He is the one who gives us everything.
- B. Know that when we give God from our money or buy something for the church we must get the best.
- C. Offer help in cleaning and organizing the class as part of their gift to God.

### **Bible Verse**

**"Be not forgetful to entertain strangers."**

(Hebrews 13:2)

### **Teaching Aids**

1. Felt figure and flannel board.
  2. A bottle of perfume.

### **Instructions**

- (1) Review last week's lesson.
- (2) Who remembers the verse?
- (3) Remind the children about the church occasions for the coming week.
- (4) Teacher should prepare the appropriate questions to emphasize the objectives during the lesson.

## Story Time

Jesus was in a town called Bethany. A man called Simon invited Jesus to have dinner with him. Jesus accepted his invitation. Simon invited his friends and his neighbours and made a great feast. (Describe it as a big party).

Jesus came and he was happy to sit among those good-hearted people. While they were sitting, a woman carrying a jar of expensive perfume entered Simon's house. She desired to express her love for Jesus, so she poured the perfume on Jesus' head.

(This action was normal in those days, and it was an evidence that the host desired to honour and entertain the guest).

She also poured the perfume on His feet. The sweet smell of the perfume filled the house. The woman dried Christ's feet with her hair and kissed them. Jesus was pleased with her because what she did was good.

- 2 - Continue the discussion while they do the activity.
