Teaching Aids

- (3) Make sure that children have gained a spiritual growth from the lesson, virtue such as loving one another, and good habits such as staying quiet in church.
- (4) Repeat the same steps with every lesson that you will be able to review based on the available time.
- (5) Remember that we review the spiritual gain for the children more than testing their knowledge.
