Notes for Servants

- ★ Truly God Your promise is true because You said, "Everything you ask in your prayer believing you will get it."

- ★ How many people crowded around Jesus without having faith in Him, so please God do not permit that I'll be one of them.

Objectives

- C. Learn to pray with faith to God for their needs.

Teaching Aids

Instruction

- (1) Review last week's lesson.
- (2) Who remembers the verse?
- (3) Remind the children about the church occasions for the coming week.
- (4) Teacher should prepare the appropriate questions to emphasize the objectives during the lesson.

Story Time
