### Notes for Servants

### Introduction

## Story Time

There was a wedding in a town called Cana. Jesus was invited to the wedding. His mother, Mary, was invited, also.

When people celebrate a wedding, it is a time to wish for happiness. It is a time to enjoy things such as food and drink. But, at this wedding in Cana, the wine was gone before the celebration had ended. Mary went to Jesus and said, "They have no more wine."

Jesus did not say that He would help, but His mother knew that He would. She turned to the servants and told them, "Do what He tells you to do."

On the floor there were six large jars. Jesus said, "Fill the jars with water." The servants put water in all the jars. Then, Jesus said, "Take some of the water out and bring it to the steward." The steward was the man in charge of the servants. He tasted the water, but something strange had happened. The water was not water. It was very good wine!

The steward did not know what Jesus had done. He said to the man who was getting married, "People usually serve the best wine first. But you have saved the best wine until last." Jesus had turned the water into wine. This was a sign that He was a very special person. It also showed that Jesus wanted people to celebrate and be joyful.
