Notes for Servants

- ★ Jesus spent His time on earth travelling from one place to another to educate and return people to God's way. We should do the same by putting as much time as possible to raise our children in God's way.
- ★ We must follow His path and teach our children His commandments.
- ★ We should examine ourselves and be sure to practice what we teach our children.

Introduction

- (1) Review last week's lesson.

Story Time

After Jesus was baptized in the Jordan River, His special work began. His work was to teach people of God's love for us and what we must do to make God happy.

Jesus left His home and went to teach in a busy town called Capernaum. The town was on the shore of the Sea of Galilee and many fishermen lived there. Jesus told the people of Capernaum the good news about God and His love for them. Jesus made people happy and healed the sick among them. He helped people in trouble.

One woman was very sick with a high fever. Jesus visited her and made the fever go away. The woman got up from her bed and felt good once more. People heard about this kind and helping person called Jesus. Many sick people came to see Him. Jesus put His hands on sick people and made them well again. This is called miracles.

The people of Capernaum wanted Jesus to stay there with them. But Jesus told them that He could not stay with them for very long. He must go to tell the good news about God's love to all the people in other places too. Jesus left His teaching for us in the Bible. He is in heaven now watching us, helping us and healing our sickness. God's teaching is written in the Bible.
