### References

Matthew 14:13-21, Mark 6:30-44.

### Notes for Servants

- ★ God does not perform miracles unless it is necessary for the benefit of the believers.
- ★ The Jews asked Him to perform a miracle, but He did not answer them because they only wanted to test Him.
- ★ But when they were in the wilderness and were in need of a miraculous deed, Christ gave them enough food to eat, be filled and have some food left.

### Objectives

**General:** God's power and His care for us.

- A. Express how they feel when they are hungry and there is no food.
- B. Explain how the people felt before and after this miracle.
- C. know that Jesus give us everything, food, cloth, toys, etc.

### Instructions
