### References

Mark 10:48-52.

### Notes for Servants

- ★ Beloved servant, do you think that you can see everything in your life? If you do then you are really blind and you do not know where you going.
- ★ If you feel that there are many things happening to you or around you, that you do not see or know, then cry to Him that opened the blind man's eyes to open yours.

### Objectives

**General:** Jesus' power and His care for us.

**Specific:**

The children will be able to ...

- A. Know that Jesus is strong and has power over everything.
- B. Learn to pray when they or any of their families or friends are sick.
- C. Believe that Jesus always answers us when we pray to Him.

### Bible Verse

**“ Jesus, have mercy on me. ”**

### Teaching Aids

1. Felt figures and flannel board.

### Instruction
