References

Luke 10:30-37.

Notes for Servants

- ★ Beloved servant, we should take our Lord Jesus as an example. As He sacrificed Himself for us, we should do the same to others, especially for our children.
- ★ Have you experienced the labour in your service as an indication for your love to God and to others?

Objectives

General: Loving one another.

Specific:

The children will be able to ...

- A. Learn the meaning of loving and helping other people.
- B. Apply love by helping their friends when they fall down or cry.

Bible Verse

"Love thy neighbours as thy self"

(Mark 12:31)

Teaching Aids

1. Picture for the lesson.
1. Felt figure and flannel board.
2. Video.

Instructions

- (1) Review last week's lesson.
- (2) Remind the children about the church occasions for the coming week.
- (3) Servant, do not exaggerate on the occupations of the three persons before the Good Samaritan.
- (4) Teacher should prepare the appropriate questions to emphasize the objectives during the lesson.

Story Time

Once upon a time, there was a man travelling to Jericho through the mountain, no trees and no water. Some robbers grabbed him, beat him up, took his money and left him on the road side hurt badly. He could not move or get up.

It was not long until a Jewish priest came by. The injured man could not speak or cry to ask for help. The priest was in a hurry, so he did not help him but went on his way.

After a while a deacon passed by and saw the man, but he looked to the other side and did not offer any help and went on.

Then, a Samaritan man stopped. He loved to help other people and give to the poor. As soon as he saw the wounded man he felt sorry for him. He went to him cleaned his wounds and put bandages on them. Then, he put the man on his own donkey and took him to an inn and looked after him.

Next day, the good Samaritan gave the innkeeper money to look after the wounded man and told him that if he needed more money, he would give him on his way back.
