## Notes for Servants

## Teaching Aids

## Instructions

- (1) Review last week's lesson.
- (2) Remind the children about the church occasions for the coming week.
- (3) Teach the children how good it is to pray to God.
- (4) Teacher should prepare the appropriate questions to emphasize the objectives during the lesson.

Mary told her that maybe she was doing something that upsets Jesus.

That same night, while the two sisters were sleeping, Nancy saw heaven opened and beautiful angels came down to her and told her that Jesus loved her very much, but he is unhappy. Swearing is wrong she will not be able to talk again until she stops swearing. Then, the angel went away.

Nancy tried to talk, but could not. She cried a lot and prayed in her heart because she was not able to talk. She prayed to God to forgive her sin and let her talk again. After a while, the angel came down again and told her that Jesus heard her prayer. Then, He touched her tongue and she started to talk again. She knelt down on her knees and thanked Jesus and promised never to swear again.

Next morning, Nancy woke up and told her sister all about her dream and since that day she learned how to stand still and always closed her eyes when she prayed.
